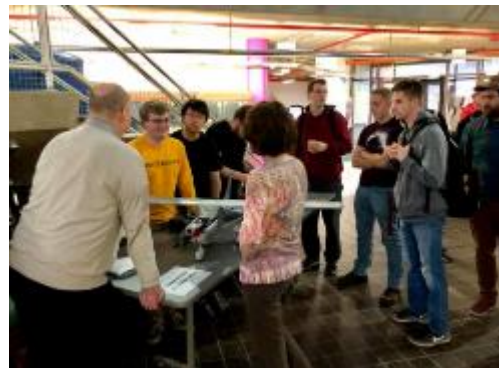
ALCC “Career Tips” Campaign

Four local law enforcement agencies sent representatives to act as “interviewers” for 8 student “interviewees.” SUNY Broome’s Business Club helped to sponsor the **Business Mock Interviews** on the 29th. Nine students participated and 5 professionals from area businesses, including Visions, the Rumble Ponies, Security Mutual Life, BAE Systems and Levene, Gouldin & Thompson were on site as Interviewers. Both employers and students reported this as being a valuable experience!

Students will be able to "shop" at our Career Closet for FREE professional clothing so they can look and feel confident during interviews. More info to come!!!

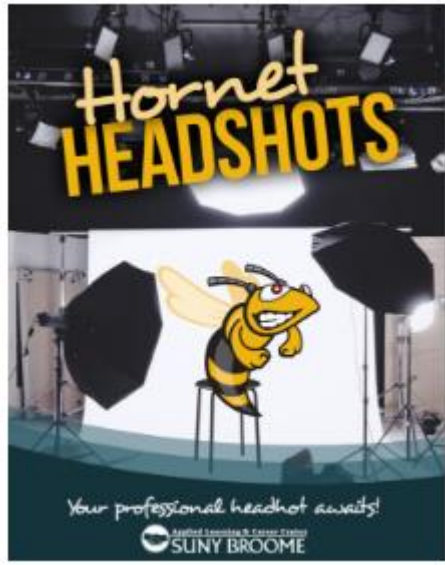
Coming in November...
