The Application Process:

Step One: The student and staff from the Global Experiences/Study Abroad Office will complete the “Student Information” section.

Step Two: Students shall submit a 1-2 page essay describing what they hope to achieve through their chosen Faculty Led Program.

Step Three: Students will need to obtain at least one faculty, administrator or academic department recommendation letter. A faculty advisor will need to complete the Academic Reference Form.

Step Four: The complete application and supporting documentation will be submitted to a campus committee for review.
