Admissions

REQUIREMENTS



- Completion of an associate's degree, or 60 or more transferable credits (including 30 credits in nursing) from an accredited institution.
 - Some applicants may need additional credits to meet prerequisite, liberal arts, or graduation requirements. Keuka College offers several convenient and affordable options to earn these credits.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must hold an unencumbered NYS Registered Nurse (RN) license at the time of application or must earn an unencumbered RN license in NYS by their second semester in this program.
- Applicants must demonstrate an appropriate combination of maturity, experience, and motivation.
