The Application Process:

Step One: The student will complete the "Student Information" section.

Step Two: Students shall submit an essay (minimum one page in length) addressing the following questions:

- a. Why do you want to participate in a Faculty-Led program?
- b. What do you hope to gain from this experience abroad?
- c. Why did you choose this particular program and/or country?

d. What are your academic and career goals and how will this Global Experience help you attain these goals?

Step Three: Students will need to obtain at least one faculty, administrator or academic department recommendation letter. A faculty advisor will need to complete the Academic Reference Form. **Step Four:** The complete application and supporting documentation will be submitted to a campus committee for

review.
