

# Opioid Overdose Intervention Training

The NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services will be sponsoring a **FREE Opioid Overdose Intervention Training Session** on **November 7th from 6:00 to 7:30 pm** at Nimmonsburg UMC in Fellowship Hall.

During this training, participants will learn to recognize, respond to, and reverse an opioid overdose using naloxone. Naloxone's unique chemical nature has been instrumental in reducing the number of fatal overdoses related to opioids.

Naloxone training sessions are vital for people to recognize and respond to an opioid overdose.

Once trained to administer naloxone, it's a simple process, but has the potential to save a life.
