Mentors

- Volunteers from the student body are screened, trained, and supported by local school district staff and the NYSMP team
- Commit to being a role-model to their Mentee for the academic year
- Gain valuable experience and perspective working with a diverse group of students

Colleges/Universities

- Determine structure with the NYSMP depending on student schedules
- Establish screening and training process with the NYSMP team
- Create Mentor selection process and decide if academic credits can be given



Mentees

- Elementary, Middle, and High School students
- Mentee participation is voluntary and includes Parental/Guardian consent
- Benefits from support and encouragement provided by Mentor and program coordinators
