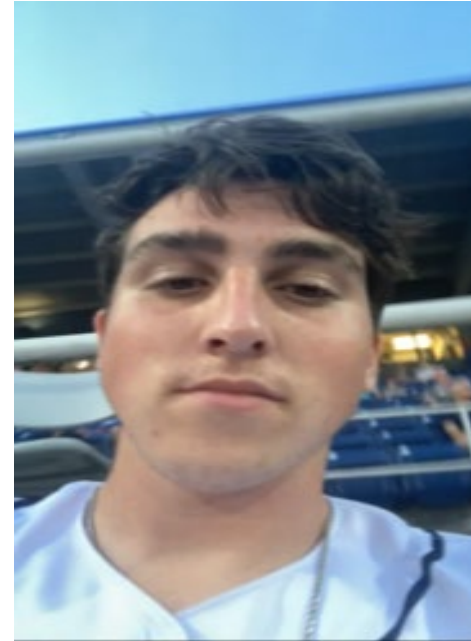

I love to go to the gym, go to parks to play basketball and run, and teach people mathematics and physics.

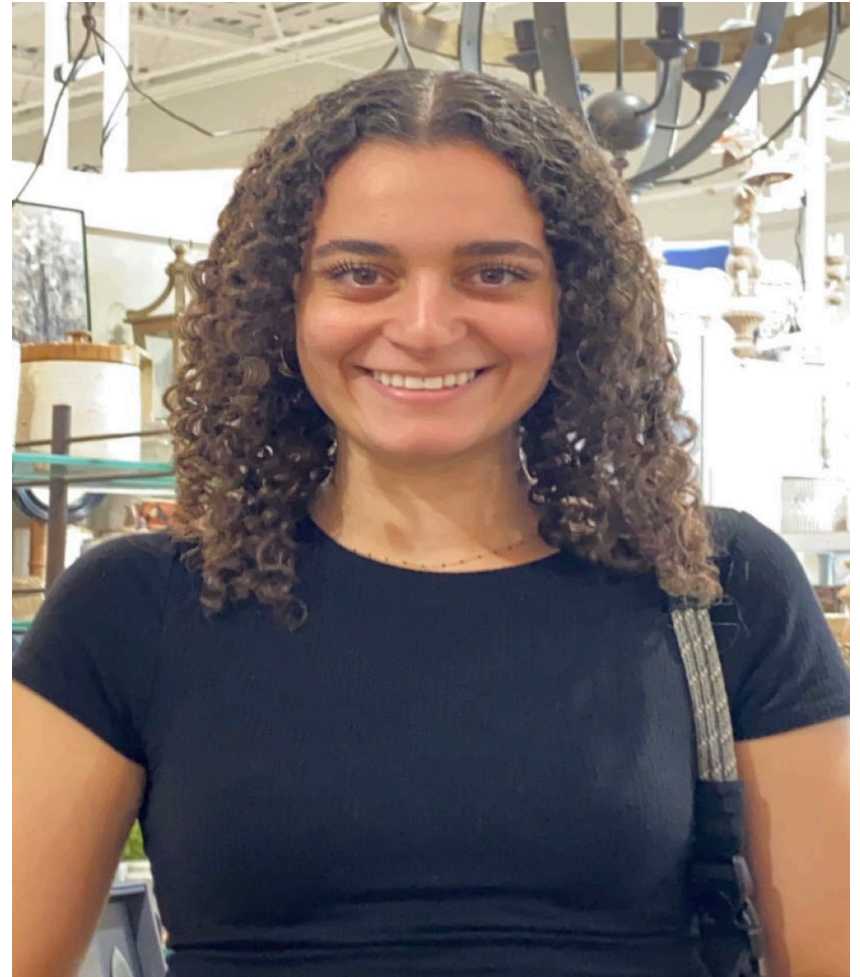


Gianna Ricci
