The rink will go pink on Saturday, March 28, for the annual Hockey 4 Hope charity hockey game at SUNY Broome's Ice Center.

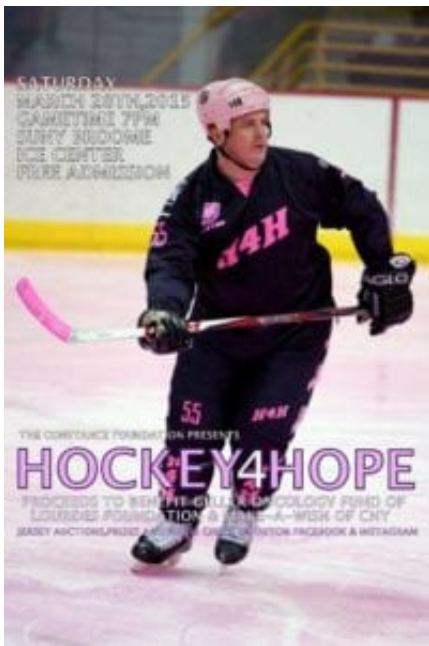
The event, which runs from 7 to 9 p.m., also includes silent auctions, raffles and other prizes. Admission is free.
