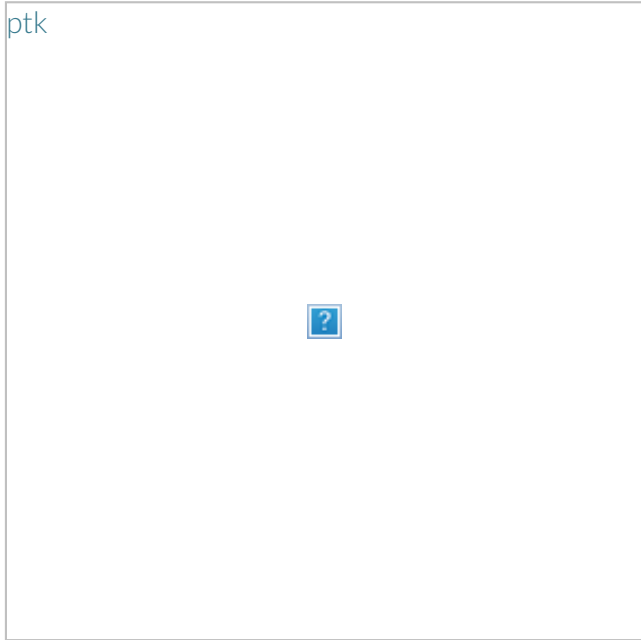

Recent accomplishments by members include selection to the prestigious **All-New York First Academic Team, receipt of the NYS SUNY Chancellor's Award Medallion, receipt of the Guistwhite Scholarship Medallion, and receipt of the Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholarship.** In 2015, the SUNY Broome chapter of Phi Theta Kappa earned the distinction of being named a **Five Star Chapter** and was awarded the **International Hallmark Award** for its role in the campus' Convocation Day activities.
