

Paper-free job applications: SUNY Broome adopts digital employment software

Applying for a job at SUNY Broome? You'll save both time and paper thanks to the college's new employment software system, Interview Exchange.

The system, which was implemented in late August, is entirely digital. Many other colleges use the system, noted Human Resources Officer Lynn Fedorchak.

To apply for positions, users head to <https://sunybroome.interviewexchange.com> to view vacancies and click on an available position. They will be asked to either set up a new account or log into an existing account, and then answer questions electronically and upload their resume. Once they apply, they also will have the option of uploading additional documents, if desired.

"It's more efficient and better for everyone," Fedorchak said.
