SUNY Broome will hold its fourth annual Mock Environmental Exposure Disaster Event at 2 p.m. Friday, May 8.

Students from more than 17 departments across campus gain valuable real-life experience in their field of study as they participate in the mock environmental exposure disaster. Departments include Medical Assisting, Nursing, Health Information Technology, Radiologic Technology, Physical Therapist Assistant, Dental Hygiene, Clinical Laboratory Technologies, Criminal Justice and Emergency Services, Theater, Communications, Hospitality, Business Information Technology, the Office of Marketing and Communications, Physical Education/Sports Studies and Public Safety.

This year's mock disaster event will involve 34 victims. Students must care for these victims using skills and knowledge learned in their respective programs. Faculty will monitor the activity providing feedback as necessary.

Students will find out what disaster awaits them on the day of the event, in order to learn how to manage a scene without prior knowledge or details.
