The Traffickers – Film Screening of Angelo Zuccolo's Last Performance

See a film screening of late Professor Angelo Zuccolo's last performance from 5 to 6:30 p.m. Monday, May 11, in Decker 201.

"The Traffickers" centers around illegal human organ trafficking. Private detective Stuart Tyrrell discovers a young woman on the side of a road near the fictional upstate city of Birnam, NY. The girl dies from her serious injuries via a gunshot to the back. The girl's identical twin sister, Lynn Harrington, arrives from Boston to identify her sister's body; she hires Tyrrell to find those responsible for her sister's murder. Those responsible are members of an international trafficking organization dealing in human organs. Lynn's sister was caught up with the gang but fled when she found out her life would be forfeited. Lynn is kidnapped by the gang as a replacement for her deceased, identical twin sister and Tyrrell must rescue her before she can be flown out of the country to Russia, where certain death awaits her.

"The Traffickers" was shot in Binghamton, Johnson City, Endicott and Endwell for \$7,000. The cast is all local and includes Christopher Keeler, Talia Saraceno, James Gormley, Tony Yajko, and the late great Angelo Zuccolo.
